Its cure in Islam

- Surah Al-Falaq & Surah An-Nas – These are powerful in protection against jealousy (hasad) and evil.

The Prophet ﷺ said:

“Do not make your houses like graveyards. Shaytan flees from the house in which Surah Al-Baqarah is recited.”

(Sahih Muslim, Hadith No. 780)

Surah Al-Baqarah is a cure for black magic. Playing or reciting it in the home regularly drives away Shaytan.
